The Lynden City Council may also remand the matter back to the Lynden Public Works Director for further review.

Any person wishing to comment may do so by attending the public hearing on April 7, 2025, and/or by submitting written comments to Jon Hutchings, Public Works Director, by 5:00pm on April 6.
