Summary Statement:	<p>The Lynden Historic Preservation Commission (LHPC) terms for Patricia Leach, Troy Luginbill and Karin Schulhauser expired on December 31, 2019 however, all have expressed a willingness to serve another term.</p> <p>These three members were appointed to the original LHPC in 2016 and have contributed valuable architectural and historical expertise to the Commission as Lynden’s historic preservation program was becoming established.</p> <p>Appointments to the LHPC are made by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council. It is the Mayor's recommendation that Patricia Leach, Troy Luginbill and Karin Schulhauser be re-appointed to another three-year term.</p>
