Based on the 2021 flooding event and the unprecedented infrastructure bill passed at the		
federal level, there was interest from the small cities group to consider engaging a federal

Based on the information and review of projects presented by the City, CFM felt Lynden was a good candidate to apply for federal grant programs and potentially receive funding. Specifically for the Pepin Creek project(s) and Bradley Road.

There may be a coalition of several small cities and the County forming a group for flooding mitigation, however, that effort will be led by the County and most likely not occurring until a later date in 2023.

The Mayor has discussed the possibility of joining with a federal lobbyist at the Finance and Public Works committee meetings.
