Legal

- RFP process to select vendors and service providers that meets competitive purchasing laws
- RCW 39.34 Inter Local Cooperation Act
- Contract between City and Trane

- No government oversight, contracts are directly negotiated with the City and Trane
- City is responsible to manage Trane's contract

Design-Build Process

- · Potential for faster delivery
- Select the preferred design team
 - o No RFQ needed
 - o Time & Effort saved
- Budget certainty at 30-60% design level vs 100%
- Collaboration between owner, designer, and contractor- early and often
- Scope creep identified early and quantified early
- Risk for changes/unforeseen conditions is low

Costs

- Firm fixed cost reduces risk
- Firm fixed cost per Omnia pricing agreement and invoiced to the City by Trane
- Standard AIA style invoicing
- Perception that first cost is higher than traditional design bid projects

Washington Dept. of Enterprise Services

- Contract between City and DES and DES with Trane

- State Program Manager assigned to project for oversight
- DES responsible to manage Trane's contract
- Potential for faster delivery
- Select the preferred design team
 - o No RFQ needed
 - o Time & Effort saved
- Budget certainty at 30-60% design level vs 100%
- Collaboration between owner, designer, and contractor- early and often
- Scope creep identified early and quantified early
- Risk for changes/unforeseen conditions is low
- Guaranteed maximum cost reduces risk
- All costs substantiated by the DES before passing to the City
- Some clients have found DES pay confusing and inflexible
- DES requires a fee for their service
- Perception that first cost is higher than traditional design bid projects



Energy Savings

- Option to provide guaranteed savings but not required
- Energy savings will be quantified if a guarantee is provided, or for any potential rebates or grants but are not required
- Measurement and verification and guaranteed energy savings is optional

- Guaranteed energy savings required
- Energy savings are required for the entire project
- Measurement and verification is required on all pieces of the project and there is a cost to this service
