

RESOLUTION NO. 998

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY OF LYNDEN, WASHINGTON
TRAVEL POLICY DATED MAY 2002

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City of Lynden (City) to reimburse City employees for all necessary and reasonable travel and related expenses incurred while on City business; and

WHEREAS, the City's Travel Policy established the guidelines for reimbursement of travel expenses; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this policy is to provide consistent application and use of travel funds and vehicle usage; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to modify the Travel Policy to current rates and standards; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing recitals are material findings and declarations of the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY the City Council of the City of Lynden as follows:

Section A: City of Lynden Travel Policy dated May 2002 is amended as stated in the attached Exhibit A. Underlined text indicates insertions and strike-outs indicate deletions:

Section B: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this code and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact than any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases has been declared invalid or unconstitutional, and if, for any reason, this ordinance should be declared invalid or unconstitutional, then the original ordinance or ordinances shall be in full force and effect.

Section C: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by the Council and after its approval by the Mayor, if approved, otherwise, as provided by law and five (5) days after the date of its publication.
