Summary Statement:		
<p>Staff recently solicited bids for the Main Street Bridge Project. This project provides for the relocation of Pepin Creek across Main Street approximately 200 feet east of the existing Pepin Creek/Main Street culvert crossing. The work to be performed under this contract shall include excavation and grading of a new channel section for Pepin Creek and construction of a single-span prestressed, precast concrete girder bridge with shallow foundations, abutments, retaining walls, moment slabs, approach panels, and sidewalks. Work will also include installation of curb and gutter, sidewalks, storm drainage, sanitary sewer, water main, and other work, all in accordance with the Contract Plans, Special Provisions, the Standard Specifications, including the amendments thereto, and Standard Plans. Five bids were received on April 26, 2022. Reichhardt and Ebe Engineering prepared the attached Bid Tabulation.</p> <p>The Public Works Committee at their April 6th meeting concurred that the bid results could be forwarded directly to City Council after informing them of the results. The Committee was advised of the bids and concurred to recommend award to Interwest Construction, Inc., the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, in the amount of \$3,069,391.80 including Washington State Sales Tax. The low bid included a minor irregularity (a signed, but unstamped notary) which the City Attorney reviewed and determined to be immaterial. This project will be funded in part with State Department of Commerce funds. The balance of the funding will be from water, sewer, and stormwater utility funds (which qualifies for ARPA reimbursement).</p>		
Recommended Action:		
That City Council award the contract for the Main Street Bridge Project to Interwest Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$3,069,391.80, including Washington State Sales Tax, and authorize the Mayor to sign the contract.
