Below is a list of the items you will need, as well as the associated instructions for completing CPL application process.

- 1. An application. If you mark "yes" to item 2 or 3 in the residency section, please provide a copy of your permanent resident alien card or alien registration and alien firearms license number.
- 2. A check or money order made payable to The City of Lynden in the amount of \$49.25. Cash is accepted in person only. **DO NOT** send cash in the mail.
- 3. A photocopy of your state-issued drivers license or identification card. Your current address must be listed with DOL but does not need to be on your card. You can update your address for free at www.dol.wa.gov.
- 4. You must live within the city limits of Lynden to be issued a CPL by the Lynden Police Department. If you are unsure if your residence is within the city limits, you are encouraged to check with the Lynden Police Department before beginning the application process.
- 5. You may contact **Prints by Appointment/ Tom Erickson at (360) 961-2318** to arrange to have your fingerprints taken. Separate fees apply to this service and are payable to the fingerprinting service provider.

Upon receipt of your completed items (including receipt of your fingerprint card from the service provider), there is a 30-day processing time to receive your CPL. Please be aware that your application will be returned to you if any portion is incomplete.
