Summary Statement:	<p>Briahna Murray, Vice-President of Gordon Thomas Honeywell Governmental Affairs, has been Lynden's State advocate advocated since 2015. That advocacy has resulted in more than \$8 million worth of capital earmarks for important City projects. The attached contract is virtually identical to its predecessors and continues the relationship with Ms. Murray and her firm. Cost: \$3,000 monthly for a total of \$36,000 in 2022. The rate is unchanged from previous years and is included in the proposed 2022 budget.</p>
