Re-appointment of Historic Preservation Commissioners – Mark Bratt and Denny DeMeyer		
Summary Statement:		
<p>The Lynden Historic Preservation Commission (LHPC) terms for Mark Bratt and Denny DeMeyer expired on December 31, 2018, however, both have expressed a willingness to serve another term.</p> <p>Both Mark and Denny were appointed to the original LHPC in 2016 and have contributed valuable architectural and historical expertise to the Commission as Lynden’s historic preservation program was becoming established.</p> <p>Appointments to the LHPC are made by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council. It is the Mayor's recommendation that both Mark Bratt and Denny DeMeyer be re-appointed to another three-year term.</p>

Motion to confirm the re-appointment of Mark Bratt and Denny DeMeyer to the Lynden Historic Preservation Commission for a three-year term beginning January 2019 and expiring on December 2021.
