<b>Summary Statement:</b>		
<p>The City passed an ordinance addressing prohibited uses and activities in City Parks but provided no process for law enforcement to follow to exclude persons from the parks.          This ordinance will allow any law enforcement officer of the City of Lynden to temporarily exclude from city parks anyone who violates provisions of the City code or any park rules.</p> <p>Parks Committee reviewed the ordinance at their meeting on October 18 and agreed to forward the ordinance to full council for approval.</p>		
<b>Recommended Action:</b>		
Motion to approve Ordinance 1637 allowing for the exclusion of anyone who violates provisions of the Lynden Municipal Code or Park rules by written notice and authorize the mayor's signature on said ordinance.
