Severe rainfall in and around Whatcom County from the period of January 20th, 2020 to February 10th, 2020, resulted in a significant rise in rivers waters throughout the area, specifically with the Nooksack River. The City of Lynden (Applicant) Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) experienced significant damage to their outfall, levee/dike system, and riparian zone adjacent to the WWTP that had just completed a total restoration in November 2019.
