Summary Statement		

Public Works applied for and received a Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) grant to fund pavement reconstruction at the intersection of 1st and Main Street. The scope of work includes grinding and overlay of two inches of HMA from curb to curb, including the intersection of 1st and Main Street, replacing the five existing non-compliant ADA ramps, and restriping the roadway to the existing configuration including marked crosswalks. The grant is for a maximum of \$374,239, which is 80% of the estimated total project cost. The remaining 20% \$149,435, is budgeted in the Transportation Benefit District fund.

Recommended Action

That City Council approve the project cost and authorize the Mayor's signature on the agreement with the Transportation Improvement Board for 1st and Main Street intersection improvements.
