Summary Statement		
The City has contracted with Whatcom County's Jail Work Crew program since 2021. Services provided by this crew include basic vegetation clean-up and debris removal. Work may include weed whacking, trimming, weed pulling, and grass and blackberry cutting. Whatcom County provides transportation of crew members, oversight, tools and safety gear for assigned work.		
In the past, contracted work has occurred during the summer and included removing overgrown vegetation from dry detention ponds and cleanup around the ponds. While this is not a service the City uses every year, deploying jail work crews allows City employees to perform higher-level duties while still delivering necessary maintenance.		

The Public Works Committee reviewed the contract at their January 8 meeting and recommended approval by City Council.

Recommended Action

That City Council approve the contract with Whatcom County for Jail Work Crew Services and authorize the mayor's signature on the contract.
