Summary Statement			
Washington State Budgeting, Accounting, and Reporting System (BARS) Manual 3.8.2.20 requires that the legislative body pass an ordinance or resolution to establish the rules and regulations for the reimbursement of travel expenses. The City last updated the Travel Police through Resolution 998 in 2019.			
 As part of updating the City's employee policies, the Travel Policy has been updated. These changes include: Look and format of the policy to align with internal policy document structure. Although the format is different, much of the content remains the same and aligns with relevant RCWs, BARS, and Lynden Municipal Code requirements. Removing specific values for meals or mileage reimbursement rates by referring the reader to rates allowed by the Internal Revenue Service. This reduces the need to update the policy annually to align with current expected costs.
