Summary Statement:			
At the July 15 th City Council meeting the members raised issues and concerns related to the development of the Pepin Creek Subarea. As you will recall the Plan was last revised and approved by the Council in August of 2021 and a Resolution of Intent to revise the backbone of the roadway			

The issues raised by Council seem to fall into the following categories:

- Public financial contribution toward residential development in Pepin seems as if it would be disproportionate to other residential development in the City.
- Potential negative impacts (traffic and parks) to increase development within the Pepin area but also to the City as a whole.
- Housing density within the Pepin Subarea and reluctance to see high density housing here.
- Residential development as a cost burden to the city without the balance of additional economic development.
- Fisheries approvals for the relocated creek.

- Use of "permitting fees" for new developments.
- Affordable housing not likely in Pepin Creek then where?
