
#### **Draft Survey Results**

In the summer of 2024 the Community Development Department conducted a survey to collect community feedback regarding the long-range plans for the growth of the City of Lynden.




1. Tell us about you! How do you interact with Lynden? Please select all that apply.






3. Which characteristics contribute the most to Lynden having a small-town atmosphere? Please select up to 3 responses.



4. How can the city enhance its connection to agriculture? Please select all that apply.




5. Thinking ahead to the year 2045, what initiatives excite you most about the potential changes in our community? Please select up to 3 responses.




6. What is your opinion of the overall quality (appearance, age, condition, property maintenance, etc.) of the housing stock in Lynden?




7. Please indicate your level of agreement with the following statement: Finding suitable housing in Lynden has been difficult for both residents and those considering relocation.




8. If you or someone you know has encountered barriers to accessing suitable housing, what barriers were experienced? Please select all that apply.




9. Which types of housing do you believe are most needed in Lynden? Please select up to 3 responses.




10. How should Lynden work to address the regional-scale housing affordability crisis? Please select up to 3 responses.




12. What are the biggest challenges facing Lynden's economic growth? Please select all that apply.




13. Please indicate your level of agreement with the following statement: It is safe to walk or ride a bicycle in Lynden.




14. How would you rate the quality of the current state of transportation connectivity with walking or biking within Lynden?




15. Please indicate your level of agreement with the following statement: Safe and convenient routes for kids to walk or bike to school in Lynden deserve attention and improvement.





18. How important is it to you that Lynden maintains its small-town feel while developing recreational opportunities?






20. Have you ever experienced any of the following events in this area? Please select all that apply.




21. How worried are you about the potential impacts of climate change on Lynden?




22. Which of the following natural hazards are most concerning to you? Please select all that apply.



23. Which actions should the community prioritize to improve climate resilience? Please select up to 3 responses.




24.To what extent have you been affected by natural events in this area in recent years (e.g., floods, droughts, wildfires)?




