Summary Statement:	<p>Discussion arose in the Public Safety Committee to allow the City and other public entities (including school districts) to use wheeled all-terrain vehicles (WATV), also known as utility terrain vehicle (UTV) for maintenance purposes on city streets with a speed of 35 mph or less. These vehicles must be owned and operated by a public entity and meet all the safety requirements of the state RCW, meet the additional requirements of LMC 10.17, and must be inspected annually by the Lynden Police Department. The Public Safety Committee reviewed this ordinance at its April 6th meeting and recommended taking the ordinance to City Council for approval.</p>	
Recommended Action:	Council makes a motion to adopt ordinance 23-1668 and authorize the Mayor's signature.
