Summary Statement:		
<p>Briahna Murray, Vice-President of Gordon Thomas Honeywell Governmental Affairs, has been Lynden’s State advocate advocated since 2015. That advocacy has resulted in more than \$9.0 million worth of capital earmarks for important City projects. The attached contract is virtually identical to its predecessors and continues the relationship with Ms. Murray and her firm.</p> <p>Key terms of this agreement include:</p> <p>Scope: The full Scope of Work is delineated in Attachment A on page 4 of the consulting agreement. It includes a range of duties required to advance the City’s 2023 Legislative Agenda.</p> <p>Cost: \$3,500 monthly for a total of \$42,000 in 2023. The rate is included in the proposed 2023 budget.</p>
