Dear Danielle,

As you are aware, we are supplying Industrial Concrete Forms for a construction project of the Chippewa Housing to be constructed by Cupps Masonry. We are requesting permission to send a Preston Feather pickup truck and trailer along with a driver and unloading assistant to the jobsite to facilitate a smooth, damage-free delivery. (Pictures of the equipment below.)

The Nudura brand ICF product we are supplying comes in 18" tall by 8' long foam billets with delicate plastic inserts and are packaged 3 per bundle, weighing approximately 50 lbs. per bundle. They are easily damaged and there is no efficient way to handle this product – it must be hand-loaded and hand-unloaded and cannot be handled by forklift.

In addition to the fragile nature of this product, it has a 4 week lead time from out of state and would cause significant delays and costs to the project should any replacement product need to be ordered due to damage.

To reduce the risk of damage caused by the additional handling (unloading at ferry dock, transloading to drayage, risk of wind damage, etc.) associated with typical deliveries to the island using the ferry and drayage process, we feel that it is in everyone's best interest to permit us to deliver this product directly to the jobsite.

Based on the project schedule we are intending to deliver the materials on Thursday, April 4th. We anticipate the total time that our equipment would need to be on the island would be approximately 1 hour with our trained & experienced team handling the delivery.
