We appreciate your patience and guidance in finalizing these details and remain at your service should you need any further adjustments or clarifications.

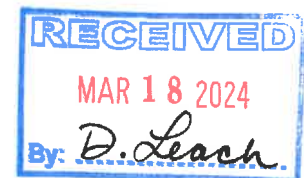
