## Total IIJA Funding Announced for California

As of October 25, 2022, California has had **\$16.2 billion**<sup>i</sup> announced in Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) funding (formula and discretionary). Of this amount, **~\$14.04**<sup>ii</sup> **billion** is dedicated to transportation-related projects and **~\$2.19**<sup>iii</sup> **billion** is dedicated to clean energy, power, and environment projects.

## Total Projects Funded with IIJA Funding

As of August 26, 2022, California has invested **\$1.34 billion**<sup>iv</sup> in transportation projects.

## Total Jobs Created (based on 13,000 jobs per \$1B invested)

Since August 26, 2022, **17,386 jobs**<sup>v</sup> have been created in California.

## Investments in Disadvantaged Communities

As of October 4, 2022, a total of **\$3.76 billion** on 843 Active Transportation Program projects will benefit disadvantaged communities throughout California. Four of the 208 projects in Northern California, totaling \$14.7 million, are statewide initiatives, which support transportation partners across California to increase their opportunity to successfully deliver active transportation projects. Moreover, **93.8% of Active Transportation Program project dollars (\$3.76 billion out of \$4.0 billion) benefit disadvantaged communities.**<sup>vi</sup>

## Disadvantaged Business Enterprise

From October 1, 2021 through August 2022, Caltrans has awarded **20 percent** of contracts to Disadvantaged Business Enterprise. Our goal for Federal Fiscal Years 2022-2024 is **22.2 percent.**<sup>vii</sup>

### Other Noteworthy Items

- December 23 – President Biden signed a third short-term continuing resolution (CR) to keep the government open through fiscal year 2023, while the \$1.7 trillion Congress-passed government funding package readies for his signature. President Biden is poised to sign the *Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2023* this week.

Notably, the *Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2023* includes an amendment sponsored by **Senators Alex Padilla (CA)** and **John Cornyn (TX)** allowing state, local, and tribal governments to use parts of their federal COVID aid allotments for a wide variety of infrastructure projects (not just water, sewer, and broadband, as the COVID laws originally provided).

Additionally, Senator Padilla announced the *Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2023* includes **\$428 million in federal funding for 200 projects across California**. Highlights of the legislation and more information on California's projects can be found at the following website:

- December 19 – The U.S. Department of Transportation's (US DOT) Federal Transit Administration (FTA) announced 15 grants in nine states to help make it easier for people with disabilities and mobility needs to access some of the nation's oldest and busiest rail transit systems through essential upgrades, such as elevators. California was not awarded a grant, though California's applications are unknown at this time.
