2024 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Adopted

SUMMARY:

The California Transportation Commission (CTC), at its March 21-22 meeting, adopted the 2024 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The STIP includes funding from the Interregional Transportation Improvement Program (ITIP) for the following projects in the Madera region:

- SR 99 South Madera project (SR 99 – Avenue 7-12) – this project received an additional \$5.5 million to fully fund the project.
- SR 99 North Madera project (SR 99 – Avenue 17-21), received \$4.3 million in funding to begin Environmental and Permit (E&P) work.
- New High Speed Rail Station – \$80 million was awarded to assist with the construction of a new station in Madera County for California’s Interim High-Speed Rail (HSR) Service.

A press release, included in your package, was circulated on March 22, 2024, announcing the STIP adoption, which included the Madera projects.

Also, at the March 21st CTC meeting, Chair Guardino presented a short YouTube video of Colorado Governor Jared Polis and Utah Governor Spencer Cox on the importance of civility.
