

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 2026-171-R**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR  
TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVE PROGRAM (TAP) PROJECT  
FOR HUGHES ROAD SIDEWALK**

**BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Madison, Alabama, as follows:

- I. That the City Council authorizes the Mayor to apply for Alabama Department of Transportation “FY 2027 Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program (TAP)” funding from the Federal Highway Administration in the amount of \$1,000,000 (\$800,000 Federal and \$200,000 sponsor match); and
- II. This funding, if awarded, will be used for the construction of a new accessible sidewalk along the eastern side of Hughes Road from 577 Hughes Road to Conger Road; and
- III. If tap funding is awarded, the City of Madison agrees to pay required expenses, including but not limited to \$206,343.75 (\$200,000 for 20% matching funds plus \$6,343.75 for non-eligible project costs); and
- IV. That the TAP application be executed in the name of the City of Madison, by its Mayor, for and on its behalf; and
- V. That the agreement be attested by the City Clerk and the seal of the City of Madison be affixed thereto.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that upon the completion of the execution of the agreement by all parties, that a copy of the agreement be kept on file by the City Clerk.
