RESOLUTION NO. 2025-373-R

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING AND ESTABLISHING THE SALARY FOR THE CITY CLERK-TREASURER OF THE CITY OF MADISON, ALABAMA.

WHEREAS, pursuant to §11-43-3, Code of Alabama, 1975, the City Council may provide for the appointment of the City Clerk-Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Alabama Code §11-43-7 and §11-43-8, it is the responsibility of the City Council of the City of Madison, Alabama to establish the salaries and fees of municipal employees and officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MADISON, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The annual salary of the City Clerk-Treasurer is established at \$111,100.08 per year, provided, however, that the occupant of said office may receive salary adjustments pursuant to the Personnel Policies and Procedures of the City of Madison and applicable City ordinances.

Section 2. The City Clerk-Treasurer shall be appointed and shall serve in accordance with Chapter 2, Article III of the Madison City Code, and also shall have the powers and duties outlined in the job description approved by Council Resolution for this position, and in other applicable ordinances and resolutions of the City.

Section 3. The person appointed to the City Clerk-Treasurer position shall be appointed for a term coextensive with that of the Mayor, conditioned upon good conduct and efficiency. However, the City Clerk-Treasurer may be subject to removal for just cause pursuant to the Personnel Policies and Procedures of the City of Madison and applicable City ordinances.

Section 4. **Lisa Thomas** is appointed as the City Clerk-Treasurer effective November 10, 2025.
