### SCOPE

This protocol applies to all patients that require treatment for anaphylaxis at Mangum Regional Medical Center.

### PROCEDURE

#### Nursing Orders:

- Lay patient flat
- Check vital signs x1
- Place patient on Pulse Oximetry
- Oxygen administration to keep saturation greater than or equal to 95%
- Cardiac Monitor
- Saline Lock x1

#### Radiology and Other Procedures:

- ECG 12 Lead Panel

#### Medication Orders:

- Certirizine 10mg PO x1
- Diphenhydramine 25mg IV x1
- Diphenhydramine 50mg PO x1
- Diphenhydramine liquid \_\_\_\_ (up to 1mg/kg) PO x1
- Epinephrine 0.3mg IM x1
- Epinephrine 0.15mg IM x1
- Famotidine 20mg IVPB x1
- Famotidine \_\_\_\_ (0.5mg/kg) IVPB x1
- Hydrocortisone 50mg IV Once
- Methylprednisolone 40mg IV Once
- Normal Saline \_\_\_\_ (20mL/kg) IV Bolus x1
