# ORDINANCE NO. 465

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS FOR THE CITY OF MANGUM, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING TITLE 7, CHAPTER 8, SECTION 7–8–4, STRIKING LANGUAGE RESTRICTING BICYCLE EQUIPMENT BEING REQUIRED ONLY IF THE BICYLCE IS OPERATED ON A STREET WITH A SPEED LIMIT GREATER THAN 25 MILES PER HOUR AND CHANGING THE TIMES WHEN A FRONT EMITTING LIGHT AND REAR EMITTING LIGHT MUST BE EQUIPPED; AMENDING ALL ORDINANCES, POLICIES, OR RESOLUTIONS AT VARIANCE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and the Board of Commissioners of the City of Mangum, Oklahoma, the following:

**Section 1.** Title 7, Chapter 8, Section 7–8–4(a) is amended by striking the language "this subsection does not apply to a street or highway with a speed limit of 25 miles per hour or less," and requiring a front emitting white light and a rear emitting red light be installed from one-half hour before sunset to one-half hour after sunrise, resulting in the ordinance to read as follows:

(a) Every bicycle in use any time from one-half hour before sunset to one-half hour after sunrise must be equipped with a lamp on the front emitting a white light from a distance of at least 1,000 feet to the front, and the lamp on the rear emitting a red light visible from a distance of at least 1,000 feet to the rear.

#### Section 2. Severance

If any court with proper jurisdiction or any act by any legislature makes any provision of this ordinance invalid, the remainder of such ordinance will remain in full force and effect.

### Section 3. Repealer

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are repealed and amended to reflect the changes provided by this ordinance.

### Section 4. Emergency Clause

It being immediately necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety of the City of Mangum, Oklahoma, and its inhabitants, an emergency is declared to exist. By reason of the emergency, it is necessary that this ordinance goes into effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and publication.

#### Section 5. Publication

O.S. § 14–106 & 14–107 in the Mangum Star-News within 15 days of its adoption and cause proof of such publication to be attached to this ordinance.

## ORDINANCE NO. 466

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS FOR THE CITY OF MANGUM, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING TITLE 7, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 7-3-2, BY ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 25 MILES PER HOUR ON ALL CITY STREETS UNLESS OTHERWISE POSTED; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; AMENDING ALL ORDINANCES, POLICIES, OR RESOLUTIONS AT VARIANCE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and the Board of Commissioners of the City of Mangum, Oklahoma, the following:

**Section 1.** Title 7, Chapter 3, Section 7–3–2 is amended by adding a new subsection (c) that will read as follows:

(c) No vehicle may be driven at a greater speed than 25 miles per hour upon any street or highway within the City except when a different speed limit is otherwise designated and posted.

### Section 2. Severance

If any court with proper jurisdiction or any act by any legislature makes any provision of this ordinance invalid, the remainder of such ordinance will remain in full force and effect.

## Section 3. Repealer

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are repealed and amended to reflect the changes provided by this ordinances.

### Section 4. Emergency Clause

It being immediately necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety of the City of Mangum, Oklahoma, and its inhabitants, an emergency is declared to exist. By reason of the emergency, it is necessary that this ordinance goes into effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and publication.

### Section 5. Publication

The City Clerk is authorized and directed to publish this ordinance in accordance with 11 O.S. § 14–106 & 14–107 in the Mangum Star-News within 15 days of its adoption and cause proof of such publication to be attached to this ordinance.
