



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX RATE

Proposed Tax Rate	\$0.847548	per	\$100
No-New-Revenue Tax Rate	\$0.869266	per	\$100
Voter-Approval Tax Rate	\$0.847548	per	\$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2026 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for the City of Manor from the same properties in both the 2025 tax year and the 2026 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest rate that the City of Manor may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of that rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that the City of Manor is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2026 tax year.

Public hearings on the proposed tax rate will be held on September 8, 2026, and September 16, 2026, at 7:30 p.m. at Manor City Hall, 105 E. Eggleston Street, Manor, Texas.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, the City of Manor is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Manor City Council at City Hall or by attending the public hearings mentioned above.

Your taxes owed under any of the tax rates mentioned above can be calculated as follows: Property tax amount = tax rate x taxable value of your property/100

The 86th Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by the City of Manor last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by the City of Manor this year.
