AGENDA ITEM DESCRIPTION:

Consideration, discussion, and possible action on an Ordinance ordering a Special Election to be held on November 3, 2026, for the adoption of amendments to the Manor City Charter.

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

A special election is ordered to be held in the city on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City propositions on whether the Charter of the City of Manor should be amended. The special election shall be held and conducted by the Travis County Elections Officer, pursuant to a contract authorized by state law, and such election may be held as a joint election with Travis County and/or any other government jurisdiction contracting with Travis County therefore and located within the same territory as the City. The proposed amendments shall take effect upon their adoption and the entering of an order by the City Council declaring the amendments adopted.

The Final Notice of Special Election will address polling locations for both Early Voting and Election Day to the registered voters of the City of Manor, Texas. Notices will be published on the city's webpage and the local newspaper as required by the Texas Election Code.
