

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-07

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANOR, TEXAS SUPPORTING THE CONTINUED PARTICIPATION OF THE MANOR POLICE DEPARTMENT IN THE TEXAS TRAFFIC SAFETY COMPREHENSIVE STEP (SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM) - CLICK IT OR TICKET (CIOT) GRANT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2026; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTATION; AND DESIGNATING THE CITY MANAGER AS THE AUTHORIZED OFFICIAL FOR ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE GRANT, INCLUDING FUTURE FISCAL YEARS; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Manor, Texas (the “City”) is a home-rule municipality; and

WHEREAS, the STEP (Selective Traffic Enforcement Program) Comprehensive Click it or Ticket (CIOT) grant (the “STEP Comprehensive CIOT Grant”), authorized through the State of Texas, Texas Department of Transportation, and funded by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, provides funds to local agencies to conduct traffic enforcement aimed at reducing crashes, injuries, and fatalities caused by intoxicated driving; and

WHEREAS, the Manor Police Department has participated in the STEP Comprehensive CIOT Grant program since 2019 and seeks to continue its involvement to further enhance traffic safety within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City (the “City Council”) desires to authorize the City Manager to execute all necessary documentation for the fiscal year 2026 and for all subsequent fiscal years under the Texas Traffic Safety Program STEP Comprehensive CIOT Grant as long as the grant program is provided; and

WHEREAS, the City Council designates the City Manager as the grantee’s authorized official for all matters pertaining to the grant for fiscal year 2026 and future fiscal years; and

WHEREAS, the City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Texas Department of Transportation funds, the City assures that the funds will be returned to the Texas Department of Transportation in full; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of its citizens for the Manor Police Department to participate in the Texas Traffic Safety Program STEP Comprehensive COIT Grant for fiscal year 2026.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANOR, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1. The City Council hereby approves the recitals contained in the preamble of this Resolution and finds that all the recitals are true and correct and incorporate the same in the body of this Resolution as findings of fact.

Section 2. The City Council hereby approves the participation of the Manor Police Department in the Texas Traffic Safety Program STEP Comprehensive CIOT Grant for fiscal year 2026 and for all future fiscal years, as long as the grant program continues to be available through the Texas Department of Transportation.

Section 3. The City Council hereby designates the City Manager as the authorized official for the City and hereby authorizes the City Manager to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the City for fiscal year 2026, execute all necessary documentation regarding this grant and for all subsequent fiscal years under the Texas Traffic Safety Program STEP Comprehensive CIOT Grant.

Section 4. If any section, article, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word in this resolution or application thereof to any persons or circumstances is held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution; and the City Council hereby declares it would have passed such remaining portions of the resolution despite such invalidity, which remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, and it is duly resolved.
