AGENDA ITEM DESCRIPTION:

Consideration, discussion, and possible action on proposed City Charter Amendments.

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

Per City Charter Section 13.08, the council is required to review the charter every two years to determine if any amendments should be considered. The council must also appoint a Charter Review Commission, consisting of seven qualified voters from the city, at least every five years. The previous Charter Review Commission was appointed in 2020.

The Charter Review Commission was appointed by the City Council on July 16, 2025. This advisory board is responsible for evaluating and recommending updates or amendments to the city's charter. The Commission's duties include reviewing the current governing document, analyzing legal and procedural aspects, and proposing changes to enhance governance, efficiency, transparency, and accountability. Their work ensures that the city's constitution aligns with current needs, laws, and best practices, supporting the city's ongoing development and operations.

The Commission met, reviewed, and discussed proposed charter amendments on the following dates:

August 7, 2025
 September 4, 2025
 October 23, 2025
 November 13, 2025
 November 20, 2025
 December 4, 2025
 January 8, 2026

The Charter Review Commission is now presenting its recommendations to the council, recommending the conduct of a Special Charter Amendment Election in November 2026.
