AGENDA ITEM DESCRIPTION:

Consideration, discussion, and possible action on Roadway Impact Fees.

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

Using the Roadway Impact Fee project and cost list, as divided amongst the three service areas, the Advisory Committee can review each service area's roadway impact fee. Neighboring cities' impact fees are provided as a reference. As with water and sewer impact fees, the maximum assessable roadway impact fee is 50% of the total, unless a plan is developed to credit ad valorem taxes generated by new service units for payments of those improvements.

The Committee can recommend different roadway impact fees for residential and non-residential uses.

Service Area 1:

Revised total cost = \$17,480,000

Proposed RIF = \$622.71/service unit

Service Area 2:

Revised total cost = \$18,615,000

Proposed RIF = \$728.71/service unit

Service Area 3:

Revised total cost = \$24,050,000

Proposed RIF = \$465.88/service unit
