



PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the City of Manor recognizes the importance of parents talking with their teens about alcohol and other drugs in order to reduce the risks and dangers posed to teens and communities; and

WHEREAS, high school students who use alcohol or other substances are five times more likely to drop out of school or believe good grades are not important; and

WHEREAS, 27 percent of middle school students try alcohol before graduating from 8th grade, significantly increasing the risk that they will develop alcohol problems later in life; and

WHEREAS, underage drinking contributes to more than 4,300 deaths among people below the age of 21 in the U.S. each year: and

WHEREAS, the majority of kids say their parents are their primary influence when it comes to decisions about drinking alcohol; and

WHEREAS, PowerTalk21®, started by Mothers Against Drunk Driving® (MADD) in 2011, is established to encourage parents and caregivers to embrace their important role in influencing America's youth and their decisions about drinking alcohol and using other drugs; and

WHEREAS, in 2022, MADD encourages parents to use PowerTalk 21, as part of Power of Parents® program to create a sustained and prolonged conversation about underage drinking and other drugs among middle school and high school students; and

WHEREAS, to equip parents to talk with their teens about alcohol, MADD Central Texas on April 1, 2022 – May 31st will launch PowerTalk 21 to give parents the tools to effectively talk to their children about alcohol and other drugs to protect them; and

WHEREAS, I urge all citizens to join in the local and national efforts to raise awareness of the importance of parents and teens talking together about alcohol to reduce the risks and dangers posed to teens and communities; and
