AGENDA ITEM DESCRIPTION:

Consideration, discussion, and possible action on entering into a finance agreement for the purchase of a new in-car and body camera system for the Police Department and authorizing the sale of old equipment.

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

MPD has been with the current system since 2007 (15 years). The system currently being used has been purchased by a larger corporation which has affected the warranty, support and replacement of parts and the entire systems capabilities, use and dependability. This contract includes a \$321,952.33 discount(s) and does not include the projected 13% price increase to the product advised by the manufacturer effective January 1st, 2023.

It is the city staff's recommendation that the City Council approve and authorize the City Manager to sign the finance agreement with Axon Enterprises, Inc. for the replacement of the Police Department's in-car and body camera system; and authorize the Manor Police Department to sell replaced video equipment (with report back to Council); and for the 1st year of payment being \$9,999.95 due prior to January 1, 2023 and 0% interest payments starting in 23-24 B.Y. at \$207,188.55 for 5 years.
