AGENDA ITEM DESCRIPTION:

Consideration, discussion, and possible action on the name change of the Education Committee to the Community Collaborative Committee.

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

This community committee was established and added to the Home Rule Charter in November 2020. Article X. Planning and Development; Community Committees – Section 10.10 Community Committees reads:

- a. Community Collaborative Committee. The Community Collaborative Committee shall serve to promote communication between the City and the community on issues affecting the city as a whole. The Community Collaborative Committee shall include representatives from the city's homeowners' associations, community non-profit associations, the school district, charter schools, and other members of the community as determined appropriate by the City Council.

The Education Committee (Mayor Pro Tem Hill, Chair and Council Member Amezcua) recommended for the Education Committee name to change to the established Community Collaborative Committee to be able to include all entities described in the charter to promote same purpose.
