


To City Council:

My name is Maggie and I am the company representative for Lone Star Sales and Vending LLC. We own the skill games located inside the Fogata Market. It has come to my attention that there is a location restriction. Per Code Section 4.006.008, coin operated machines are prohibited from operating if they are located within 300 feet of a church, school, or hospital. In this case, it is a church. I would like to put in a waiver request to be heard by city council for them to waive the distance requirement for machines placed closer than 300 feet to a church, school, or hospital. We have the full support of the church and they are providing a letter of support. I also wrote a letter of support. We are only referring to 3 machines. There usually is only 1-2 people playing, and they don't disturb anyone in the time that they are playing the machines. The fogata market is not a nuisance business, and Duc Lu has great relationships with the businesses around him. If the machines aren't disturbing anyone, can we please reconsider? He has been in your town for many years and has never caused any problems. He deserves the chance, just like everyone else.
