AGENDA ITEM DESCRIPTION:

Consideration, discussion and possible action on an Interlocal Agreement Between Manor Independent School District and the City of Manor for the Summer Library Program.

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

The City Council is being requested to support the 2026 Summer Library Program that will utilize multiple Manor ISD campuses. The three (3) campuses in Manor are scheduled to be open three (3) days a week for 23 days, starting on June 1st through July 31st, for a total of 7 hours per day. In 2025, the Summer Program hosted family events in the evening and coordinated with its Food Service Division to provide free breakfast and lunch to students who participated in the program. The goal for 2026 is to support 400 youth throughout June and July to improve their literacy and provide a safe program environment with a healthy meal option, all in a supervised setting.

With the city’s ongoing support for youth-driven summer initiatives and the collaborative support from Manor Independent School District, we are able to address an area of concern for afterschool programs that achieve positive outcomes and increase literacy. As the City of Manor strives to maintain a vibrant and inclusive environment, families with school-aged children benefit from our efforts to build a sense of community and a place they call home. The city’s commitment to maintaining and providing a structured summer program with the school district will leave a lasting impact on the children and families who utilize this service.
