AGENDA ITEM DESCRIPTION:

Consideration, discussion, and possible action on a service agreement implementing leak detection in the city's Water Distribution System for water pipelines.

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

This proposal is for water leak detection for 83.2 linear miles of pipeline within our Water Distribution system. This initiative aims to enhance the safety and efficiency of our operations by identifying and addressing any leaks promptly. The State regulations mandate that we compile and submit detailed reports on the water lost in our distribution system each year. Three contractors submitted proposals, and SAMCO Leak Detection Services, Inc., was the lowest bid at \$64,480.00. Funds were budgeted in this year's Water Department budget for this leak detection service.
