Public Works Department

Street and Public, Parks, and Maintenance Department

In March, the Public Parks and Maintenance Department mowed all city facilities, alleys, and right of way. They cleaned and maintained all the city facilities and parks. They performed all maintenance on city vehicles and heavy equipment, and the Street Department repaired streets, curbs, and signs.

Water and Wastewater Department

In March, the Water Department performed daily maintenance on the water system, repaired water mains, set water meters, and tested the water daily. The Wastewater Department performed daily maintenance on the wastewater plant. Anthony Townsend received his collection class III license.

Water Production & Purchase

In March, 40 % of the water we supplied to our residents was from our wells, and we purchased 60% from EPCOR and Manville WSC.
