

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-18

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MANOR, TEXAS AUTHORIZING
A MULTIPLE USE AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT
OF TRANSPORTATION (TXDOT) TO REQUEST THE
CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE, AND OPERATION OF A PUBLIC
PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE AT 10598 EAST US HIGHWAY 290, ADJACENT
TO SHADOW GLEN BOULEVARD ALONG THE NORTH SIDE
RIGHT-OF-WAY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Manor City Council authorized the installation of a pedestrian bridge over the creek near Shadow Glen Boulevard along the north side right-of-way on US290; and

WHEREAS, the City of Manor City Council approved the installation of a public pedestrian bridge at 10598 East US Highway 290, adjacent to Shadow Glen Boulevard along the north side right-of-way at their April 16, 2025, Council meeting; and

WHEREAS, the City of Manor hereby requests that TxDOT allow the construction, maintenance, and operation of a public pedestrian bridge at 10598 East US Highway 290, adjacent to Shadow Glen Boulevard along the north side right-of-way and the necessary access and use of said right-of-way.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANOR, TEXAS:

Section 1. The facts and recitations set forth in the preamble of this resolution are hereby found to be true and correct.

Section 2. The City of Manor, Texas, hereby requests that the Texas Department of Transportation authorize the construction, maintenance, and operation of a public pedestrian bridge at 10598 East US Highway 290, adjacent to Shadow Glen Boulevard along the north side right-of-way.

Section 3. Severability. If any clause or provision of this resolution shall be deemed to be unenforceable for any reason, such unenforceable clause or provision shall be severed from the remaining portion of the resolution, which shall continue to have full force and effect.

Section 4. Repeal. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are expressly repealed.

Section 5. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective as of the date of its approval.
