ORDINANCE NO. 591

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANOR, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE ELECTION RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION OF THE CITY OF MANOR HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2020, FOR THE CITY OF MANOR'S COUNCIL MEMBER PLACE NO. 2; COUNCIL MEMBER PLACE NO. 4; AND COUNCIL MEMBER PLACE NO. 6; AND DECLARING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

Whereas, pursuant to the Texas Election Code, the City Council of the City of Manor, Texas, convened on this the 16th day of November 2020 at 10:00 a.m. for canvassing the vote in the General Election held on November 3, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANOR, TEXAS, THAT:

Section One. <u>Canvass of Vote.</u> There came to be considered the returns of the general election held on the 3rd day of November 2020, for electing three (3) Council Members, and it is appearing from said returns, duly and legally made, that there were cast at said election 4,315 votes *(total votes)*; and that each of the candidates in said election received the following votes:

It is further found and determined that in accordance with this Ordinance of this governing body that the City Secretary posted written notice of the date, place and subject of this meeting in the bulletin board of the City Hall, a place convenient to the public, and said notice having been so posted continuously for at least 72 hours preceding the date of this meeting. A copy of the return of aid posting shall be attached to the minutes of the meeting and shall be made a part thereof for all intents and purposes.
