AGENDA ITEM DESCRIPTION:

Consideration, discussion, and possible action on alternate public transportation services for the City of Manor.

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

On August 3rd, the City Council approved the placement of Proposition A on the November 8th election ballot asking the Manor citizens to vote to either continue supporting CapMetro 990 Express Services for 30-45 average number of riders utilizing 1% of the city's sales tax or vote to discontinue the service. The current 1% sales tax generates an estimated \$2.4 million per year. The City Council placed Proposition B on the November election ballot as well asking the voters to support utilizing the \$2.4 million on city infrastructure, community development, and public transportation for our citizens needing this service if the voters vote "NO" to Proposition A and "YES" Proposition B. Other communities in the area have explored alternate rideshare programs that provide specialized public transportation services for their citizens. Staff has explored several options and developing a plan that will work with rideshare service providers in the region. Steps will be taken to develop a transportation development plan to address the short term and long term needs of the community. We'll be able to identify other cost effective strategies and services as the community grows. Our goal is to make the City of Manor a community that listens to the voices of our residents and provide them with services they are requesting.
