

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, motorcycles are a common and efficient means of transportation for thousands of Texans, including many residents of the City of Manor, and motorcyclists are entitled to the same rights and consideration as any motor vehicle operator on the road; and

WHEREAS, motorcycle riding is a popular form of recreation and transportation that contributes to the economy and cultural vibrancy of our community; and

WHEREAS, motorcycle riders are more vulnerable to injury and fatality in traffic crashes than drivers of other vehicles, and increased public awareness can help reduce the number of motorcycle-related incidents; and

WHEREAS, it is essential that the residents of Manor be aware of motorcycles on the road and recognize the importance of sharing the road safely with all vehicles, including two- and three-wheeled motorized vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation and numerous organizations across the state work year-round to promote motorcycle safety and offer training programs for both riders and drivers; and

WHEREAS, May is recognized across the nation and in the State of Texas as Motorcycle Safety and Awareness Month, providing a valuable opportunity to remind all motorists to remain alert and drive responsibly.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Dr. Christopher Harvey, Mayor of the City of Manor, and on behalf of the Manor City Council, do hereby proclaim the month of May 2025 as:

"Motorcycle Safety and Awareness Month"

in the City of Manor, and urge all motorists and residents to join in promoting safe driving practices, heightened awareness of motorcyclists on the road, and mutual respect among all roadway users.
