AGENDA ITEM DESCRIPTION:

Consideration, discussion, and possible action on a Resolution for Participation in the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Home Investment Partnerships (Home) Programs; Approving and Ratifying the Cooperative Agreement for the city.

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

In 2006, Travis County was identified as an Urban County Entitlement for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The County has received CDBF Funding for the past eighteen (18) years and has allocated those funds to assist low-and moderate-income individuals and household residing in the unincorporated areas of the County and small participating cities.

The Cooperative Agreement will allow the city to actively participate with Travis County to pursue infrastructure and affordable housing resources for the different properties in the grant eligible census tracts throughout the community. This level of participation with Travis County will allow families to see the two organizations working to improve the quality of life for them and their neighbors.
