AGENDA ITEM DESCRIPTION:

Consideration, discussion, and possible action on a Resolution declaring the estimated population of permanent residents of the local municipality as of December 31, 2024.

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

To enhance safety on Manor's roadways, the Manor Police Department will begin enforcing commercial vehicle laws within city limits and surrounding areas. Under state law, municipalities must have a population exceeding 25,000 residents to qualify for certain commercial vehicle enforcement authority.

While the 2020 U.S. Census recorded Manor's population below this threshold, the law allows local governing bodies to certify updated population estimates through a proclamation or resolution. Based on recent growth and development, the City of Manor—combined with the communities of Shadowglen and Presidential Meadows—had an estimated population of 37,390 residents as of December 31, 2024.

This certification enables the Manor Police Department to move forward with commercial vehicle enforcement efforts, aimed at improving traffic safety, reducing roadway hazards, and ensuring compliance with transportation regulations.
