AGENDA ITEM DESCRIPTION:

Consideration, discussion, and possible action regarding the authorization of a construction agreement implementing the painting of the exterior of four water tanks with the newly designed City logo.

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

Proposals were submitted to paint all the city's water storage tanks and incorporate the new city logo. The existing elevated tank downtown will have the 150th anniversary logo removed and replaced with the new logo. The groundwater storage tanks will also be updated with the new logos. The project will begin with power washing all elevated tanks to remove dirt. Next, the tanks and any rusted areas will be cleaned before a fresh coat of paint is applied. Finally, the new logos will be prominently displayed, giving the tanks a vibrant and refreshed appearance. We have received proposals from three different companies to carry out this work.

The total quotation cost from Utility Service Co., Inc. is \$285,078.00, while the quotation from Maguire Iron, Inc. is \$338,500.00. USG Water Solutions offers a more favorable rate for exterior painting and adding a new logo for the east, west, and Sonic (on Murray st.) elevated tanks, while Maguire Iron, Inc. provides a more competitive price for the ground storage tanks and the Old Downtown elevated (150th) tank for the new logo.

City staff recommends that two agreements be entered into dividing the labor among the City's water tanks between Utility Services Co., Inc. and Maguire Iron, Inc. Maguire Iron, Inc. would update the logos on four water tanks: the ground storage tank and the Old Downtown elevated (150th) tank for a total cost of \$58,500. Entering into two agreements will result in a savings of \$29,638.00 for the city.

The city staff recommends that the City Council approve the Construction Agreement with Maguire Iron, Inc. to replace the 150th logo on the Downtown Tank and add new logos to three ground storage tanks in an amount not to exceed \$58,500.00 and authorize the City Manager to execute the Construction Agreement.
