AGENDA ITEM DESCRIPTION:

Consideration, discussion, and possible action on an ordinance canvassing the returns and declaring the results of the November 7, 2023, City of Manor Special Bond Election.

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

On August 16, 2023, the City Council called a special election to be held on November 7, 2023, to authorize the approval by voters in the City of bonds.

The City of Manor contracted with the Travis County Elections Office to hold and conduct the election for the City, which the election was held as a joint election on November 7, 2023.

<u>Election Results Propositions</u>. A <u>MAJORITY</u> of the residents, qualified voters of the City voting in such Election, have voted **FOR** the authorization and issuance of an amount not to exceed \$15,000,000 in bonds and the levy and pledge of the tax in payment thereof, together with the costs of any credit agreements related thereto, as provided in the Proposition. The Council hereby finds that Proposition A **DID** carry at the Election and that the City is accordingly authorized to issue and sell the bonds in accordance with the authority granted in Proposition A and with law.

A <u>MAJORITY</u> of the residents, qualified voters of the City voting in such Election, have voted **FOR** the authorization and issuance of an amount not to exceed \$61,695,000 in bonds and the levy and pledge of the tax in payment thereof, together with the costs of any credit agreements related thereto, as provided in the Proposition. The Council hereby finds that Proposition B **DID** carry at the Election and that the City is accordingly authorized to issue and sell the bonds in accordance with the authority to issue and sell the bonds in accordance with the authority granted in Proposition B and with law.

A <u>MAJORITY</u> of the residents, qualified voters of the City voting in such Election, have voted **FOR** the authorization and issuance of an amount not to exceed \$90,105,000 in bonds and the levy and pledge of the tax in payment thereof, together with the costs of any credit agreements related thereto, as provided in the Proposition. The Council hereby finds that Proposition C **DID** carry at the Election and that the City is accordingly authorized to issue and sell the bonds in accordance with the authority granted in Proposition C and with law.
