## **BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:**

The STEP (Selective Traffic Enforcement Program) – IDM (Impaired Driving Mobilization) Comprehensive Grant is authorized through the State of Texas, Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT), and funded by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. It provides funds to local agencies to conduct traffic enforcement, aiming at reducing the number of crashes, injuries, and fatalities caused by intoxicated drivers on Texas Highways. The Manor Police Department has participated in this grant program since 2019 and will continue its involvement for fiscal year 2025 and beyond with TXDOT's funding of this initiative.
