Manor City Council Presentation: Texas Internship Initiative Grant

Executive Summary

- The **Texas Workforce Commission** is offering funding under the **Texas Internship Initiative** (**TII**) to expand **paid**, **work-based learning opportunities**.
- The goal: prepare students, recent graduates, and military-related interns for middle-skill STEM careers and strengthen local workforce pipelines.
- This grant represents a collaborative opportunity between the City of Manor, Manor ISD, Austin Community College/partner universities, local businesses, and Workforce Solutions

Target Audience

- High school juniors and seniors in technical dual-credit programs
- College students in certificate, associate, or bachelor's degree programs
- Recent graduates (within one year of completion)
- Military-related interns (MRIs) transitioning to civilian careers

Grant Length & Funding

- **Period:** ~15 months with potential renewal (up to 2 years)
- Funding available: up to \$200,000 per award; state allocation of \$2M total
- Internships required: minimum 10 maximum 50
- All internships must be paid; employers receive 50% wage reimbursement (up to \$10/hour)

Potential Impact

- **Pipeline Development**: Creates a seamless transition from school to career in high-demand STEM industries.
- **Economic Growth**: Builds local capacity in advanced manufacturing, IT, energy, life sciences, and other targeted industries.
- **Talent Retention**: Provides opportunities for Manor students and veterans to **work locally** instead of relocating.
- Equity & Inclusion: Special recruitment for foster youth and veterans expands access to opportunity.

Expected Outcomes

- Workforce-ready graduates with real-world experience
- Industry-recognized credentials & dual-credit alignment
- Stronger business-education partnerships
- Improved employment and wage outcomes for participants
- City-wide recognition as a hub for workforce innovation

Roles & Responsibilities

City of Manor

- Provide community leadership and visibility for the initiative.
- Support with infrastructure, outreach, and recognition of participating businesses.

Manor ISD

- Recruit eligible **high school juniors/seniors** in dual-credit programs.
- Ensure alignment with **STEM curriculum** and career pathways.

Austin Community College / Universities

- Provide credit-bearing coursework, certifications, and faculty oversight.
- Collaborate on internship training plans.

Local Businesses

- Offer **internship placements** with meaningful, structured training.
- Provide supervision and mentoring.
- Receive partial wage reimbursement for interns.

Workforce Solutions

- Lead **program administration**, eligibility verification, and reporting.
- Facilitate employer engagement, intern recruitment, and support services (transportation, tuition assistance, certifications).
