**RECOMMENDATION:** Receive staff update on Water Supply Conditions

**SUMMARY:** Staff will provide an update on current and future water supply conditions.

**DISCUSSION:** The District relies on local reservoir storage to provide approximately 75% of our water supply with the other 25% coming from the Russian River. Overall, Marin Water's local reservoir storage is 84.8% of capacity and 125% of the average storage for this date. Additionally, the water level in Lake Sonoma is approximately 96% of the water supply pool and 140% of average for this time of year. Lake Mendocino water level is 75% of the water for both potable demands and environmental releases in the coming year. In addition to providing a review of the 2023 water year, including a summary of supplemental water purchases, staff will also review current and projected future water supply conditions.
