CEQA Exemption Status: Categorical Exemption Section 15301, Existing Facility and Section 15302(c), Replacement or Reconstruction.

Reason for Exemption: This project is Categorically Exempt pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guideline Sections 15301, Existing facilities. The project is also exempt pursuant to CEQA Guidelines 15302(c), Replacement or Reconstruction. The project qualifies for exemptions pursuant to Sections 15301 and 15302 (c) inasmuch as it includes installing a new electrical building and mechanical equipment at its current site and involves negligible or no expansion of capacity.

Project Approval: The Marin Municipal Water District Board of Directors approved the award of a contract for project construction, which represents project approval as defined by Section 15352 of the Guidelines for Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act, at their regularly scheduled meeting on April 7, 2026.

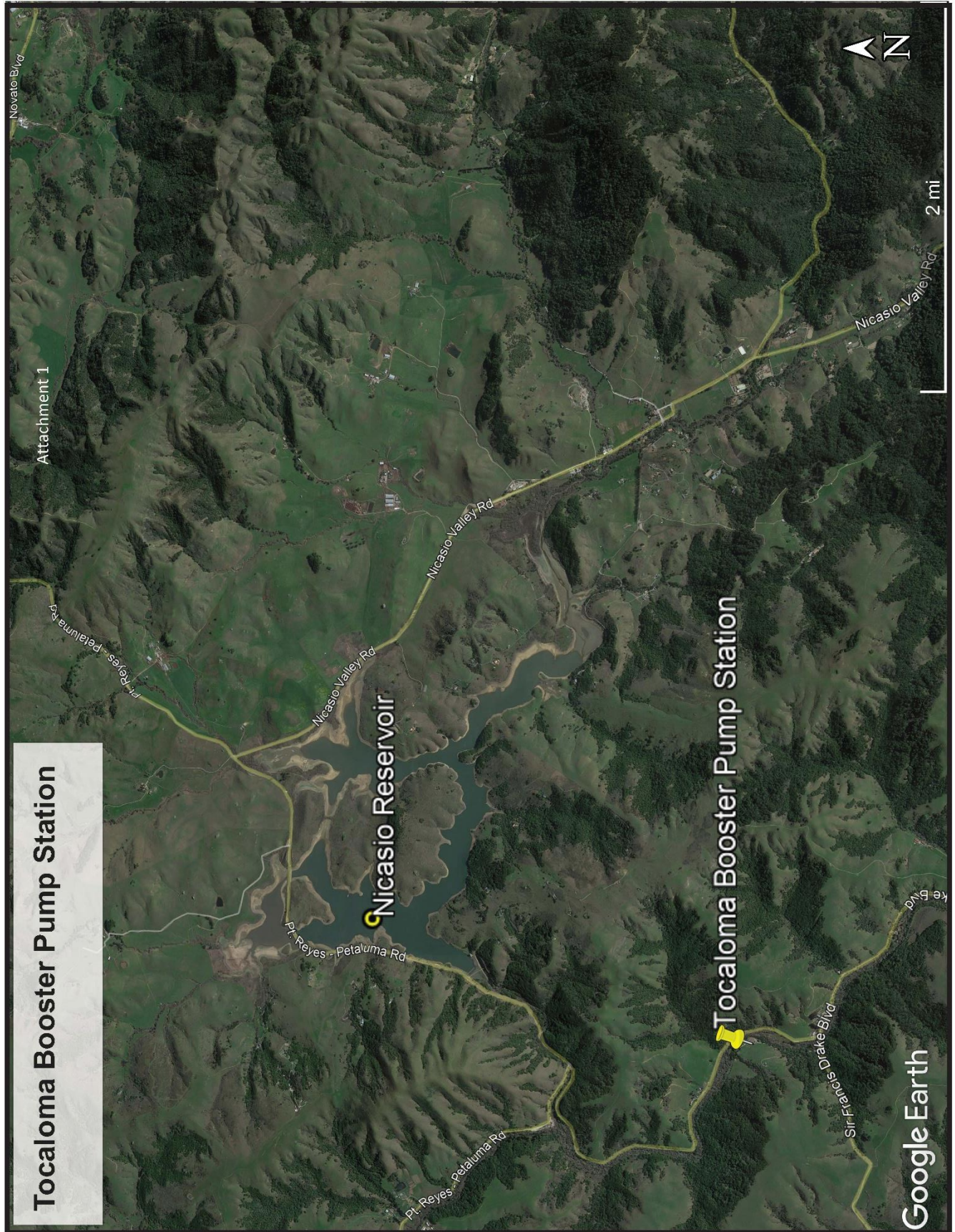


Figure 1. Area Map for the Tocaloma Pump Station Rehabilitation Project.
